Where can I legally park?

ROBINSON'S ABORTION CENTER – 1929 Record Crossing – You may park right on Record Crossing, on the street near the abortion center. PLEASE DO NOT PARK IN EITHER OF THE ABORTION CENTER'S TWO PARKING LOTS OR IN FRONT OF THE NEIGHBORING BUSINESSES! Robinson's second lot is across the street from his business, bordered with red poles.

What do I do when I arrive?

Depending on when you come, you can expect to see a 40 Days Shift Leader on site. There will be a black "Vigil Supply Box" at the vigil site. In this box, you will find a "Sign-In Sheet." Please sign this upon your arrival. Also, if you have not previously done so, please sign the "Statement of Peace." You will also find literature and prayer books in the box.

Is everyone required to sign a Statement of Peace?

Yes! By signing the statement each person is agreeing to maintain the peaceful presence that is key to the 40 Days for Life-Dallas Campaign.

Where can I legally stand?

Please stand on the sidewalks that run along Record Crossing. Please do not block any drive-ways. The entire black-top area in front of Robinson's is his private property. PLEASE DO NOT BLOCK THE DRIVEWAY OR STAND ON THE BLACKTOP. The best place for pray-ers to stand is across the street from Robinson's in front of the red poles. PLEASE DO NOT SIT ON OR ANCHOR ANYTHING TO THE RED POLES.

ADDITIONAL NOTE: We recommend that there always be at least two people praying on site. If you arrive to pray at a vigil site and are the only person there, please sign in - but please feel free to sit in your car and pray from your car. We appreciate your prayerful presence!!
