Constant Vigil

- When going to the Sidewalk, there are two primary roles which you can fulfill
 - Sidewalk Counselor
 - Prayer Support
- Both roles are important, not all are called to attempt Sidewalk counseling

Constant Vigil

- Everyone at the sidewalk is called to bring with them the Love of Christ
- Everyone participating in 40 Days for Life on the sidewalk of either abortion site is asked to submit a Statement of Peace, confirming that they will obey all applicable laws.

Reno Municipal Code

- Do not block the sidewalk
- Do not obstruct anyone entering or leaving the abortion site or neighboring properties
- Do not prop signs on light poles or other fixed objects
- Do not engage in Expressive Communication after 10 pm or before 7 am (prayer only during these hours)

Youth Participation

- Children both locally and around the country have participated in the 40 Days for Life campaign. They are valuable allies in the fight to save their own generation
- Reno Municipal Code requires that children under the age of 14 be accompanied by a parent or guardian

Reno's West End Abortion Site

- Do **NOT** Touch the fence
 - The fence surrounding the abortion site is on private property and simply touching the fence will be considered Trespass, which may be prosecuted.
