

Spring 2011 Journal – 40 Days for Life

April 13 – Day 36 361 babies saved.

Pray that those who have forgotten their purpose may discover it in God and therefore have the courage to choose life. A young man "J" asked for my rosary (a pro-life rosary with little unborn baby figures in each bead). I gave it to him. He said he has one of our pamphlets for his sister. He thanked me. I told him we'd pray for his sister & him. Both their names start with the letter "J".

April 12 – Day 35 346 babies saved!

Pray that all believers participating in 40 Days for Life will make every effort to keep the unity of the Spirit through the bond of peace (Ephesians 4:3)

A couple driving by stopped to commend us for what we're doing. They come to this area a couple of times each year for medical visits. They're Christians (not Catholic) but they praise Catholics for this effort. They're from the Grand Rapids area and are "mesmerized" by the banner on the van.

A mother and son were out for a walk. The boy, about 7 years old, stared at our group praying the rosary. The mother said to him - "Go ahead and ask them". He wanted to know what we were doing and why. Mom told us "I totally support what you're doing. Thank you"

April 11 – Day 34

The abortionist arrive about 10:30 and left at 11:30

April 10 – Day 33 316 babies saved.

As we pray for the end of abortion, let us pray for the expansion of the pregnancy help center movement worldwide.

Praise God for the opportunity to be a public witness for the Gospel of Life

Fr. Craig Giera from Guardian Angels parish with 23 of his parishioners. At 4 p.m., Fr. Alex Kratz and 12 faithful prayer warriors came.

April 9 – Day 32

Early arrivals for Abortion today. Clinic opened before 7 a.m.

A young girl (teen) came out with an older man (her dad?), got in car and was crying hard. They drove off. Didn't see them arrive – they may have left someone. A woman who was raised Catholic has 2 other children & health problems – had tears in her eyes when we talked. Still went in – 10 weeks. Another teen came out with older couple (her parents, maybe). The girl was tearful. They drove off, would not take literature. They had Indiana plates.

An older man came & prayed for an hour.

I was interviewed by Wayne State students in Broadcast Communication. We had a nice chat. Hope they get an "A". They seemed surprised by a young girl (about 11 years old) who asked if what we were doing was legal.

April 8 – Day 31 297 babies saved.

Pray for opportunities to share with an abortion-minded woman that the newness of life she is seeking is found only in Christ. A total of 12 Seminarians from Sacred Heart Major Seminary led by Deacon Nate Harburg. In addition, there were 5 other people present.

Since there is no license here at W.C. To do abortions, I suggest we tell the women that fact and that they are putting their lives in the hands of docs with no legal grounds to do abortions, It will not hurt for the women to ask to see the licenses, will it?

Not usually here at this time. Nice to see stars and a crescent moon. God's heavens are beautiful.

April 7- Day 30

Let us pray that pastors may not be distracted from the priority of caring for human lives.

Please keep the Raderbaugh family of Warren in your thoughts and prayers. Jim Raderbaugh, 42 years, passed yesterday after a long battle with cancer. His wife never lost hope that he could be cured. They have a young daughter. God, we ask that you strengthen this young family with your Grace.

Stericycle came by but did not remove any Totes with contents. Praise be to God.

Wonders from God. I was asked to pull over if I "wanted to see a baby who was almost aborted". I did and I saw the most beautiful little girl with a big toothy smile. The man & his wife would like to adopt her but there are legal issues. So we lift all up in prayer and ask God's blessing on all. PS Cass forgave me for being late.

April 6 – Day 29 – 279 babies saved!

God bless you, Warriors! Praise God for the timing of the lawsuit (one of several) on this place. Make no mistake, friends, the practice of abortions is not suspended here. Over 50% of "procedures" here continue to be abortions. Barb noted on Mar 31 that Stericycle came for "medical waste". I pray this morning for the souls of the employees and mothers for conversions and the souls of the unborn for life. Amen.

Dr. Roumell arrived at 10 and left at 11. One girl inside.

April 5 – Day 28 – 253 babies saved!

Young woman pulled in this morning and went to the door, but it was locked. She was waiting in her car. I told her about MAUBC. She was here for a yearly exam. I told her about the latest news of them being subpoenaed. She believed me and thanked me then left. I offered assistance in going to a recommended health clinic but she said she would find her own & didn't stay around. I pray that God finds a good doctor for her.
No business – just 2 employee cars in back. Praise God.
Let Your Light shine upon this place.

April 4 – Day 27

Between 8-9 a couple arrived. It was obvious they had been arguing. She got out and attempted to go inside – with what looked like 24 hour paperwork. Please pray for this couple.

Busy morning 6 customers so far this morning. Lord have mercy.

My God, I believe, I adore, I hope and I love You, and I beg pardon for those who do not believe, do not adore, do not hope, and do not love You.

About 11:30 the man mentioned above in the 8-9 note called police. Police came and said the man apparently felt threatened but all was resolved “he won't bug you and you won't bug him” in the cop's words.

April 3 – Day 26 – 247 babies saved!

Pray that we fully recognize in the unborn child our brother, our sister, and we recommit ourselves to care for them.

A woman stopped by to give a monetary donation. She is an older lady and lives in Livonia, so can't stay and pray, but - supports the Cause. She is Catholic. She has 16 grandchildren – she told me they are all “good kids” - asked for prayers for all of them.

Long discussion with young atheist adopted and raised Jewish in family that celebrated Christmas. Let's pray for him.

March 31 – Day 23 198 babies saved. Welcome Holy Name

Blessed Virgin Mary, intercede for us.

Thanks for your prayers, testimonies and news. God is awesome. Sell this place to a productive entity/group. A 2 a.m.

Traveler took a rosary for his child. Eric stopped re? About status of Womancare. Article in Detroit News.

God bless all who pray here.

Abortionist arrived at about 9:30 a.m.. A couple left at 10 – the abortionist left at about 10:30. Lord have mercy. Stericycle came at approximately 9:45 and took one red tote. May they rest in peace.

Msgr Zenz was here and led 7 faithful souls in prayer.

SUV pulled through very slow; looking over shoulder at sign then continued into neighborhood without speaking.

A young man in a car driving past, honked and flipped us off. I am always so happy when they let us know their thoughts so we can pray for them. Jesus can do something with those who are hot or cold, just not with the lukewarm.

March 30 – Day 22

Lawsuit filed yesterday by State Attorney General to close this abortion mill for illegal license. Keep praying, prayer warriors.

Amen to the above. Note about the Attorney General: Channel 7 News stopped by – the cameraman took pictures/video of the abortion clinic from three different angles. I thanked him for bringing attention to Womancare. In terms of the lawsuit filed. I assumed that's why he was here. God bless all who are praying for the end of abortion. God bless 40 Days for Life.

Praying for our legal system to provide justice in the cause to close this facility. God's power to work miracles is afoot. Pray for the medical staff to repent, and that many are brought to Jesus' loving arms today to feel His love & choose Life today for their babies. Amen.

A man in a full white van stopped & asked me some questions. He wants to come by on Friday after he gets paid & give us a donation. He goes to a Christian Church down river. Andrew stopped & prayed.

We remember 15 year old Tamiia Russell who died as a result of the abortion she received here. In justice, may this place close. When anyone stops and asks you “why are you still here? – the news said the AG shut them down”. Tell them – the

AG sued Womancare but they are still open. Even if they are not doing abortions at this time, they are still doing referrals. Plus many lives ended here and we remember.
State Police stopped by and dropped off some papers at WC.

After 6 p.m., as I was walking around bldg praying, a large full size deep red colored van pulled in parking lot and turned around & waited as if to pick someone up. I came back on side to see and continued to pray = she waited few minutes (if someone jumped in very back before I got back to side) then looked at me few times, talked on phone and left.

March 29 – Day 21 Welcome Shrine of the Little Flower

Help yourselves to donut holes in van. A man stopped by to give these to us.

Prayed with Mike the 1st hour. A great rosary for the babies! "When 2 or more are gathered ..."

Special prayers for troubled marriages /relationships. May we be aware of God's presence in our lives & may we feel the power of his love in our daily struggles. All things are possible through God. Let us put our trust in the Lord!

Fr. Joe Lang lead 11 prayer warriors this morning at 10 AM. A mother brought 3 of her children and another mother brought her baby.

Channel 4 News arrived w/camera taking pictures of building, have microphone, filmed the van. They interviewed Michelle. Nervous about the editing. Say prayer it goes well and makes the 11:00 o'clock news. Howard arrived at 8:45 and say on prayer participants. No TV crews either.

March 28 – Day 20 178 Babies saved!

We pray for humility in our work for God's Kingdom.

Today we are at the 1/2 mark of our 40 day vigil. Praise God, for all the blessings of this wonderful call to prayer by sacrifice to end abortion. Thank you to each of you that have participated in these efforts. May God continue to bless us and give us the perseverance to complete our 40 day vigil. For those of you who are here during business hours – please note activities. The work flow here has changed in recent weeks and we want to minister to those who work here and those who come for the service of abortion. God have mercy on them. Thank you. God bless you.

First worker arrived after 9 a.m.

Lord, tis good to be here. The candle I lit yesterday is still burning. 2 ladies came and went. Another lady was picked up. A man dropped off donut holes & two waters. Enjoy!. (They are in the van).

A lady drove up, went in & came out very quickly. She said we should donate our time to something "important". Told her we were called to do God's will and we will pray for her.

March 27 – Day 19 164 Babies saved! PtL.

Pray that when those representing Planned Parenthood and other abortion groups see volunteers for 40 Days for Life, they see ambassadors of Christ, and may each volunteer be consciously aware at all times of Whom we represent.

Nice morning, good to see a strong turnout of 6 people out to pray. Was not expecting that.

March 26 – Day 18 156 Babies saved.

May we absorb the truth that God is paying attention to us, and to each human life, personally and individually.

At 8 a.m., three cars at Womancare. Planned Parenthood Pink "Truth" Bus is coming to Ann Arbor today at noon. Please pray for all pro-lifers who will be there to speak the real truth.

"We the people" will survive these times, but we must work on thoughts and attitudes that make and allow horrible things to happen.

10 of my catechism kids are here to pray for the unborn. We hope we can save a baby today.

A young woman care out of the clinic (last one) & got in the passenger side of the car. I asked her to roll down her window & told her we could help if she was considering an abortion or had one. She said, that's not me. I gave her information on both sides pre-decision, post-decision. She eventually got in the drivers seat and drove off. Pretty sure she had just ended the life of her child. I'm sad. Pray for her – maybe 21-22 yrs old. Sweet face.

Note: The lanterns are in the rear of the van.

During the Memorial service, a woman and her daughter stopped by to do some business with WC but the center was closed. Had a discussion about abortion and they took some literature about the rape exception, the STD epidemic, the general SWC pamphlet and the "What's so Bad about Abortion". As they left, another woman got out of her car and handed me 2 bags of small rolls and a wad of dollar bills. She owns a bakery and said she wished we had been outside when she went in for her abortion. Maybe things would have been different. I gave her a hug and pointed to my "I Regret" button and said I understand – we are sisters. Gave the rolls to Mike M, coming off his Friday fast.

March 25 – Day 17

The snow is gone, we see the More, rocky rubble that lines the path to this door and pray, dear God, to see no more.

No signs of life. Not one car in the lot. Doors closed and dark inside. On this, the Feast of the Annunciation, I pray that our Lady will ask Our Lord for the conversion of Dr. Hodari and all abortionists, and for the transformation of our culture. Now is the acceptable day! May her Immaculate Heart triumph as we have been promised! Let our eyes see the glory of your salvation, Lord!

A gentleman stopped to ask if the clinic is still open. As he did not see any cars in the parking lot for a few days. He told me he lives in they neighborhood and he prays every time he drives by the clinic for it to close. He was a Sunni Muslim, that as most Muslims believe in the sanctity of life.

Deacon Fedewa led a prayer service with 7 other seminarians and 20 Br. Rice Warriors for Life. Praise God!

At 6:15 p.m., Dr. Roumelle arrived and a young couple followed him in. It looks like an early evening abortion. Lord have mercy!

At 6:25 p.m., Dr. Roumelle left. Five minutes later this couple left – the woman came stumbling out carrying a juice box. God have mercy!

At 8:50 p.m., a light colored SUV drove into the street parking lot. When I showed myself, it drove off at a fast speed toward 12 mile rd. At 9:45 p.m., a dark early model Lexus drove thru street lot. It drove close to me and went back onto Southfield Rd continuing south.

March 24 Day 16 132 Babies saved

Cold but inspired by the testimonies of so many witnesses to God's work. God bless you all. Pray for Bill. He has been sick and fighting it since before 40 Days started.

Stericycle truck came by and removed the remains of these slain babies. We showed our respect (and thankfully, so did the Stericycle man)

March 23 – Day 15 111 Babies saved!!

Pray that we will not become defeated by the enemy's attacks but rather call on the name of the Lord who is on our side and our help in time of trouble.

Lord, help us, your prayer warriors, to be instruments of Your Will and Your Mercy. I have knowledge of wealthy, conservative business people who claim to be pro-life. Since this abortion mill is for sale and I am a realtor of 23 years, I hope to help change ownership to close, convert or tear down this place. Many of the wealthy don't broadcast a pro-life attitude because it may hurt their company business. During 40 Days for Life here at WC, I was inspired to introduce to these people a strategy called "strawman" where they could buy a place like this and close it down but remain anonymous legally. This is an approach that may work to get rid of these places. Praise God! New battle strategy in this war against the unborn, which we are winning! Keep fighting. God bless you all.

I really like this idea. I pray it will happen.

March 22 – Day 14

Pray for the mothers going into pregnancy help centers. The personal care, the free ultrasound, the ongoing practical help is designed to deliver them from those who profit in shedding innocent blood.

Spent an hour together. Will pray for special family needs for those searching for God.

Woman and daughter drove up and I spoke with them briefly. The daughter went in 1st & I told the mother this is an abortion clinic & she ran in & got her daughter & came out in about 10 minutes. Said they are new in town & wanted to go to an OB/GYN. Told me her story & thanked me over and over for telling them what this facility is. I had put a lot of info on her windshield and she was grateful.

It is starting to get busy here.

Please pray for "Lynn". She has 3 children & doesn't know what to do. Is very grateful that I talked with her. Invited her to come have a coffee, but declined. Sweet young woman. Pray. Pray. Pray.

Dr. arrived at about 10:15

March 21 – Day 13 101 Babies saved!

We pray for the strength to love those who do not love us.

5 customer came between 9-10

Between 10 & 11, one couple arrived. A woman pulled up and the girl next to her got out and they both went inside.

Between 11 & 12, 2 women came out mad at our approach. Lord, we pray for them.

Gave one free Ultrasound card

A young woman stopped by. Her name is Chanel. She was here over 3 years ago last October and changed her mind after a brief chat with one of us. She now has a beautiful daughter, Morgan, who Chanel said completes her family (as son, Matthew and another daughter, Micah). She was in a bad spot at that time, troubled marriage, but God is so good when we do His Will. The marriage was restored, too. Also, we cannot underestimate the influence the men have. Her husband was against the abortion but he didn't prevent her from coming here. He clearly expressed his opposition, so I believe God was using him as an agent.

March 20 – Day 12 90 Babies saved!

Thank you, Lord, for my life. Wonderful testimonies in the book yesterday. Through prayer all things are possible. I love you, Jesus!

Lanterns need new batteries.

You're right. I have the. I'll bring them soon.

St. Hugo's had a turnout of 33-35 people [at the 2:00 o'clock prayer vigil led by Fr. Michael]

There were people who came out for the 1st time and hopefully will come back. Very pleased with the group. Some said they will come with their Rosary group. Others said they will come back during the week. God was with us and hopefully more will start responding to this plea for the unborn.

March 19 – Day 11

- Feast of St. Joseph – 78 babies saved!
- Pray that people of faith will have their strength renewed even in the face of the violence of abortion.
- Office worker showed up at 5:50 a.m. Dear Father, we pray for mercy for these that will take innocent lives today. We pray for the women in pain, not aware of your beautiful gift. Forgive them. Shower us with your Grace and Blessings today. I love feeling Your Presence. Amen.
- Sadly, our hopes that they would not be busy went unrealized. May our prayers bring Light, Life and healing to our Nation.
- A whole family came with the diabetic mom. Said that they didn't want abortion but all the doctors said she should have an abortion. **FYI – one couple went in, came out and drove away.**
- The abortionist arrived at 9:30 and left at 10:30. By 11 am, five women had left the building with their rides. Lord, we pray for your mercy for the innocent lives lost, for the healing and conversion of the affected mothers and fathers and those that participate in this evil. Amen.
- Everyone is gone – Joe was here between 6 & 7 a.m. He said 4 couples arrived between 6:20 and 6:40 am. Perhaps we need to make sure a sidewalk counselor is there during the early Saturday hours.
- [Fr. Dan Trapp of St. Monica, St. Augustine and Sacred Heart Major Seminary let a group of 13 people in the Memorial Service for the Slain Unborn.
Plus Gwen] stopped by to give her testimony about the power of God's grace working through us. In 1999, she came here to Womancare for an abortion. She had not been born again yet but knew enough to pray to God for guidance on what to do. She parked in the corner spot and a woman 'rapped' on her car window and told her 'Jesus wants you to have this baby'. She (Gwen) became very angry at this woman, but the woman insisted that Jesus did not want her to go inside. The staff came out and told her not to listen but something touched her soul and she remembered her prayer. So she went with the woman [to Problem Pregnancy Center] and now she is so proud of her 11 year old son. She is grateful to Jesus for restoring her to God and she has been born again and serving the Lord since 2002.
- Man named David stopped to pray Rosary on the way somewhere.
- Please pray for Barbara G. who is scheduled for cancer surgery on 3/22. Thank you.

March 18 – Day 10

- Yesterday, a gentleman stopped to thank us for praying here and to share that he tried to stop girlfriend or wife from an abortion but she wouldn't listen and spoke about being free to do as she wished with her body. He left the relationship and found out from her that she couldn't have any more pregnancies and has had 3 abortions. He had his 2 children in the car who waved to us.
- On Thursday, the Stericycle truck driver carried only one very light red container from W.C. to the truck. Is this a sign of less business?
- A large truck delivered several small oxygen tanks to Womancare today. The empty tanks were returned to the truck.

March 17 – Day 9

- Pray that the post-abortive woman would be repentant, accept forgiveness, be healed and restored, and bring glory to God with her new life.
- St. Patrick – please bless this clinic today and help save any unborn child from abortion.
- Volunteer w/ St. Pat shamrock tie stopped by with Irish cookies for everyone today. - No person's entered the clinic during this hour. Keep praying that abortion will end soon.
- Thanks for the cookies.
- Pray for a young man named David who has cancer.

March 16 – Day 8

- My "mom" in law and I had some time today and wanted to pray.
- A young man stopped by to commend the group for their dedication. He was polite & cordial but said he did (not?) share our convictions. We thanked him for his acknowledgment. When he left, we prayed for him.

March 15 – Day 7

- Blessings and encouragement. A young man in a blue SUV stopped by and left us a box of Tim Horton doughnut holes! Look in the van (if there's any left).
- My first time here in 2011 – was here a few times in 2010. I pulled up about 1:45 and a car pulled into the lot. A woman went in. I pray for her and her baby. God bless them.
- A place to "be"

March 14th – Day 6

- That those tempted to abort may understand that their child is already present, and already a real person.
- At 9:45, The lady that was inside crying had her girlfriend pick her up – not her boyfriend that dropped her off and drove off. She obviously changed her mind, so said her tears that we say her shedding so much.

March 13th – Day 5

- May God's justice sober our society; may mercy triumph over judgment.
- Praise God for the wonderful people that come here to pray.
- I see my luminary caught fire and had burned down to the sand.
- Beautiful night to pray! In just the first few days of the campaign, I can feel a difference about the positive opportunities that we'll have to witness God's love this Lenten season! I've had several new discussions with people about the 40DfL movement & they are willing to pray & come out. Thank you, Lord!
- Sometimes we're surprised by the blessing that come unexpectedly. This morning I overslept and missed the first hour and a half of my scheduled time at the prayer vigil. Something as little as that can be unsettling to me. Bill M who was scheduled before me didn't get mad but waited patiently until I arrived. That stretched Bill's prayer time to 3 1/2 hours in the wee hours. Shortly after he left a friend of mine unexpectedly pulled up to pray. Tom is a faithful sidewalk counselor with the Helpers of God's Precious Infants in East Pointe. He had never prayed at the 40 DFL before. I had sent him a 40DFL postcard about a month ago and his angel woke him up early this morning to come pray with us. It was wonderful to see Tom and spend time in prayer together.

I headed for home and got ready for 9 am Mass at the Shrine. Before Mass I learned that Fr Joe Lang had been out (unannounced) to the Vigil yesterday, the Shrine youth group(their idea not the adult leader's) is planning to sign up for an hour (for the first time) during one of the 'Shrine days', one of the Shrine High teachers (Tim P) is going to invite his class to come out with him on one of the 'Shrine days' and best of all Cathy C who prayed at the vigil yesterday during the active abortion time told me there was a 'turn' while her and Chris (her husband) were there praying. They weren't too sure of the 'turn' until they got home and compared notes. A woman who had gone inside for an abortion came out. As she got in her car to leave she called out to Chris with a smile, "I didn't do it". Chris was in deep prayer at the time and together with Cathy (who was at the other end of the sidewalk at the time) put the evidence together and realized this woman had decided to give life to her baby. Praise God!

- It is wonderful to be involved in something bigger than ourselves, something so simple everyone can do it, something that is saving lives and changing hearts. Praise God.

March 10th – Day 2:

- At least 5 girls here for abortions today. Broke my heart to see them walk in, so hard inside, refusing to talk. Father of one

baby talked to me briefly and I could see he was surprised by what I told him – but he hardened again, “you’re just pro-life, blowing “smoke”” No trust, or rather, trusting the wrong people. Tragic!
- A man stopped by to encourage us – Steve P. He is Lutheran. I urged him to get his church out here for a day.
