

Subject: RULES GOVERNING PICKETERS

Below is a list of what rules governing picketers.

Picketers may be on a public sidewalk but may not block pedestrian traffic

Picketers may be within public right-of-way areas between a sidewalk and a public street, but may not interfere with traffic

Picketers may not plant or install any signs; signs must remain mobile or handheld (this rule applies to all signage within the City)

Picketers may not trespass onto private property; any doubts about property lines or whether an area is actually a public right-of-way should be resolved before arrests for trespass are made

Picketers may not be in the street while the street is in use by vehicular traffic

Picketers may not obstruct or touch employees, visitors, or their vehicles

Signage may not be displayed in a manner that impedes the visibility of vehicle drivers who are approaching an intersection, turn, or point of entry onto the roadway

If you encounter picketers who are in violation of the above it is advised that you request the presence of a supervisor.
