Case # 93-327932 NH (Wayne County)

"Defendants failed to possess and exercise a degree of learning, skill and experience commonly used by medical professionals in accordance with the standard of care; **defendants were negligent** and failed to do the procedures in a manner that was accepted and approved by the medical profession and in accordance with the standard of care; ... they failed to administer appropriate medications; ... violating the standard of care in that they failed to tend to the patient in a manner which was in conformity of the standard of care."

Case # 96-7475 (Macomb County)

Improperly administered test showed Keri to be Rh+ (she was actually Rh-) and was not given RhoGAM when she aborted her first pregnancy. During her second abortion, Kerri was given RhoGAM but the **clinic failed to inform her** of her Rh factor, what the significance was, and why she was given RhoGAM. When Kerri continued her third pregnancy, her son Timothy was born 5 weeks premature and she had to be given a double volume exchange transfusion. Her son suffered damage to his nervous system due to the severity of Keri's antibody response (which could've been prevented) and she has now been warned about **future pregnancies** that **could prove fatal for herself and child.**

Case # 98-009981 (Oakland County)

Andrea experienced sexual assault from the staff **(unnecessary touching of the breasts with inappropriate comments)** at the time of her first trimester abortion. After the abortion, she **experienced extreme cramping and heavy bleeding** and was told it was very common. Later at her checkup appointment, she was told everything was normal. Since her pain persisted, she decided to obtain a second opinion elsewhere and was diagnosed with an incomplete abortion and **missed ectopic pregnancy (often fatal).**

Who is this man and what is Womancare?

Suits directed against Dr A. Hodari

(all cases are from public records available at the County where the case was filed)

Case # 85-504476

Bonita (age 22) was nine weeks pregnant at the time of her abortion. She experienced heavy bleeding and went into shock after **Hodari perforated her uterus** during a dilation and suction procedure. The ER doctor ruled that the wound (3 cm) was beyond repair and **she was forced to undergo a hysterectomy.**

Case# 58-515366 NM (Wayne County)

Angela was not seeking an abortion, but needed care for her unborn child who was experiencing fetal heart distress. Hodari was contacted several times and informed of the critical condition of the fetus, but **failed to attend to the child who was later born dead** due to his negligence and malpractice.

Case# 85-529757 NM (Wayne County)

Vanessa was born after her mother was given a **botched saline abortion** by Enrique Gerbi and was left to die at the clinic. Because of the acid used during her termination, she suffered blindness, mental retardation, severe scarring, burning of her hands and feet and had to undergo heart surgery. Hodari was held responsible for employing Gerbi even though he held **11 malpractice suits** against him.

Case # 86-320-211 NM (Oakland County)

Joann thought she was pregnant and wanted an abortion. She was given a pregnancy test and not informed of the negative results. Hodari charged her and **performed an abortion on her when she was not even pregnant!** During the suction abortion, he perforated her uterus and Joann had to undergo surgical repair.

Case # 89-2133 NH (Macomb County)

Kathleen suffered from a **misdiagnosed ectopic pregnancy.** After viewing her ultrasound, Hodari told her she carried a normal intrauterine pregnancy despite the severe pain she was experiencing. The next day she was rushed to the hospital only to discover that her right fallopian tube had ruptured (often fatal) and had to have it removed.

Case # 96-614993 NH (Wayne County)

Andrew was 27 weeks gestation when he was born alive, weighing 1 lb. 13 oz., after a **failed saline abortion.** Due to the acid-like substance used, he sustained severe painful bodily injuries and burns.

Tamiia, (age 15) was brought to the Southfield clinic by her 23yr old boyfriend's sister. **She didn't have parental consent,** but gave the staff a fake ID, which stated she was 19 yrs old (her cousin stated that the picture in the ID did not look anything like her). Since she was 25-26 weeks pregnant, her abortion was a two-day procedure. The first day, lami-nara was placed in her cervix to stretch it open. That night Tamiia told her guardian that she was in the middle of an abortion. Her aunt called the clinic and asked to stop the abortion, but the staff misled her to believe that it was too late and that the young girl would have to continue. Tamiia and her family reluctantly went to the clinic for the second and final part of the abortion (dismemberment and removal of the fetus). **The next morning she was found unresponsive** lying on a blood soaked mattress. **She died on the way to the hospital.**

Case # 83-269068 (Oakland County)

Christine aborted in the month of December and was told her first-trimester abortion was successful and was prescribed birth control. However, she later found out she was still pregnant. Her daughter was born in the month of July.

5) Case # 95-521-843 NH (Wayne County)

Pamela, age 23 experienced severe abdominal cramping after her abortion at 23 weeks. After being rushed to Mercy Hospital, doctors found an **8cm laceration on her uterus,** which was beyond repair. She was forced to undergo an immediate **hysterectomy and colon (bowel) resection.**

Case 94-408874 NH (Wayne County)

After her first trimester abortion, Janice (age 19) suffered **uncontrollable bleeding** due to several punctures on both her cervix and uterus. An **emergency hysterectomy** was performed to save her life. "... Womancare is independently negligent to the plaintiff by failing to use reasonable care in maintaining safe and adequate facilities and medical equipment, failing to select and retain only competent physicians, failing to oversee the patient care provided by all those who practice medicine in its walls, and failing to inform, adopt, and enforce adequate rules and policies to ensure quality care."

Case # 96-517904 NH (Oakland County)

Immediately following her first trimester abortion at the Southfield Womancare, Chivon's complaints of **stomach and chest pain were ignored.** She was sent home after being told everything was normal. Less than five hours later, **she was found unresponsive and died shortly after being taken to the hospital.**

Dr Hodari and/or his agents and employees and the agents and/or employees of Womancare of Southfield, PC. did not have the requisite skill, knowledge, training and expertise to perform an abortion upon Chivon.
